a legal right that can only be restored by the laws we create, it is incredibly important that we elect pro-life legislators.

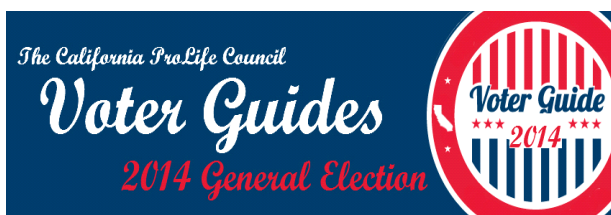

released from school for 'medical services' without parental permission. You can change this.

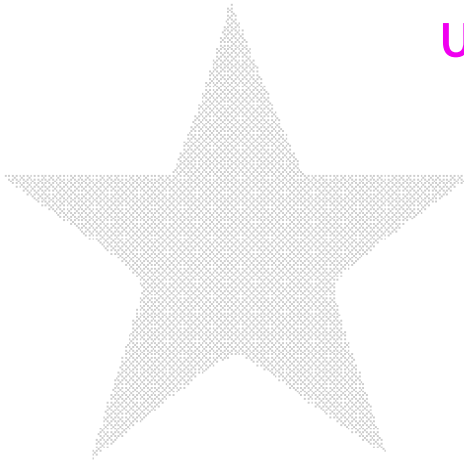
While we have positions for most of the candidates up for election, we are still lacking information for local elections.

UPDATE: Sex-Selective Abortion in California

Assemblymember Shannon Grove’s (R-Bakersfield) bill, AB 2336, which would prohibit a person from performing an abortion if they have knowledge that the purpose of the abortion is to end the life of a girl in the womb, was heard in the Assembly Health Committee on May 8th, 2014. The committee voted along party lines, 13-6, against the bill that would stop sex-selective abortion in California.

During her testimony, Grove said, “This is the real war on women: the killing of baby girls simply because they are girls. We hear often in this Capitol building about

women’s rights, equal rights for women, equal protection under the law, equal pay. Well colleagues, girls are being killed simply for being girls and it’s happening right here in California and not just third world nations.”

Every pro-abortion legislator agreed that this was a terrible and shameful use of abortion, but they were not going to support the bill because it ‘infringed’ on ‘a woman’s right to choose’.

The embarrassment was so great that—one week later—they introduced a resolution as a cop-out admission of guilt: ACR-149.

ACR-149 originally condemned femicide and gendercide abortions by making the month of May “Femicide and Gendercide Awareness and Prevention Month.” But a resolution has absolutely no weight of law. This simply gives them the appearance of seeming to support the pro-life position. Ultimately, even the resolution was quickly amended and passed to honor “School Attendance Awareness Month.”

“Be Normal & Change History!” ProLife Conference



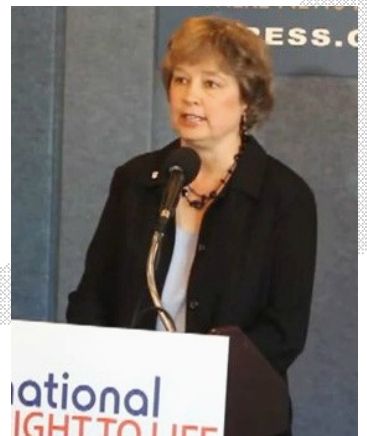
