- Proposition One (Constitutional Right to Reproductive Freedom)** on the ballot this November goes far beyond the *Roe* and *Casey* decisions and allows unlimited and unregulated abortion, prohibiting any future laws regulating abortion by altering the state's constitution:
SEC. 1.1. The state shall not deny or interfere with an individual's reproductive freedom in their most intimate decisions, which includes their fundamental right to choose to have an abortion and their fundamental right to choose or refuse contraceptives. This section is intended to further the constitutional right to privacy guaranteed by Section 1, and the constitutional right to not be denied equal protection guaranteed by Section 7. Nothing herein narrows or limits the right to privacy or equal protection.

Legal experts agree this would permit and allow state funding and promotion of all abortions and prohibit any regulations of it. The average Californian strongly disagrees with such unlimited abortion policies

2. **Statutory Protection for Unborn Children** – The recent Supreme Court decision in *Dobbs v. Jackson Women’s Health Organization* overturned *Roe v. Wade* and returned to each state the right to determine when to protect a child's life in the womb, and under what circumstances.
Do you favor any restrictions on abortion? **Please check one.**

3. **Parental Consent**

California Education Code (48205) allows school officials to require parental consent before dismissing minors for medical services, which may include abortion. This does not interfere with any other law regarding parental consent or privacy of the child.

4. **Abortion Counseling.**

Lawsuits have been brought against public schools as a result of school personnel counseling or assisting students in obtaining abortions without parental knowledge or consent. The Thermalito School District was assessed damages of \$3.2 million when a student’s abortion resulted in serious medical complications.

5. School-Based Clinics

Planned Parenthood and other abortion promoters are seeking to establish school-based “health” clinics whose primary purpose in reality is to offer contraception and abortion counseling/referral services. Studies show that where these clinics have been established, the pregnancy rate has not decreased, but in some cases the birthrate has decreased. This discrepancy is only possible through abortion.
